The previous seven awards programs were held in Albany, Augusta, Columbus, Commerce, Macon, Savannah and Valdosta during March and April. As a reward for the day's award-winning field supervisors from both general contractor and specialty contractor firms, the Chapter was honored to have Dale Murphy as our keynote speaker.
